# Community Ties Youth Provision Youth Support Worker Overview

Haxby & Wigginton Youth & Community Association are seeking to hire a confident individual to be our new Youth Support Worker. The role will assist our Senior and Project Youth Workers in delivering our youth and community provision 'Community Ties' during Term Time.

The Youth Support Worker will be responsible for supporting the Senior and Project Youth Workers in the delivery of activities, crafts and games in our Wednesday Youth Group for young people in years 5-7. The candidate will also help contribute to session ideas, support with general admin and cash handling, as well as speaking to parents when needed.

The candidate will also be required to help the other staff members to set up and put away during each session. This will include the movement of kit from storage cupboards to tables, set up and take down/sanitization of tables, chairs, and kit.

The role consists of 2.5 hours per week which includes in person delivery, set up and take down and is paid at the National Minimum Wage pay rate. Please note, this position is permanent subject to funding.

#### More about Youth Group

Delivery day: Wednesdays (term time only)

Location: Oaken Grove Community Centre, Haxby

Delivery time: 6:00pm – 8:30pm (includes 15 minutes before and after for set up and take down)

Age range: years 5-7

This is an open access provision for young people in years 5-7. We deliver a range of activities including sports, crafting, and arts, cooking/baking and more. We aim to empower young people to make positive lifestyle choices and raise aspiration levels in a fun and safe environment.

## Key Tasks

- 1. Establishing relationships and supporting general activity with the young people.
- 2. Resolving youth conflicts and dealing with challenging behaviour.
- 3. Encouraging young people to get involved in organised activity and playing games.
- 4. Supporting the running of the tuck shop and handling cash.
- 5. Articulately communicating ideas, behavioural concerns, and issues to Senior Youth Worker.
- 6. Supporting the completion of general admin for the club such as registers, letters, and forms.
